Addendum to Newsletter to Members

APPLETON ESTATE TRAVELLER'S SERIES REGATTA Ends of the Island – Evans Bay: 26 & 27 MARCH 2005

There was a disappointing turnout at this Regatta, with only four boats, Pen Wig & Ballcock, Elliot Goblit, The Blurr and Brzo. Slam Dunk had intended to compete but vehicle problems on the eve of departure from Auckland meant Cam and co. were unable to make it.

In the end, the E5.9 Regatta did not form part of the NZTYA National Championships held at the same time over the four days of Easter. Race programming and safety regulations were incompatible.

Saturday 26th: three races were held in blustery 25-30 knot northerlies. In the first race, Brzo broke its goose neck fitting, putting it out of that and the second race, but the boys got back on the water for the third race. The day featured spectacular broaches by The Blurr and Elliot Goblit in race 3. Elliot Goblit's broach resulted in a mast bend, putting Spags out for the rest of the Regatta.

A low score system is used for calculating the series results, as follows: 1st place - 1 points, 2nd - 2 points, etc
 Boats not racing score 20 points for that regatta, or number of boats +1, which ever is greater
 Best 3 scores out of 5 regattas, count towards the series result
 Boats tied on equal points will be ranked in alphabetical order until the series is complete
 Boats tied at the end of the series will be ranked using their NI Champs score as a tie-breaker
 Boats must complete 3 regattas to qualify for the series
